A local resident provided an overview of his planning application. He and his wife would like to restore some farm outbuildings, demolish others and convert the farmyard to gardens. The applicant used the plans to demonstrate the land to which the planning application applies. Councillors questioned the wording of the plan specifically regarding ancillary, Councillor Donald believed ancillary would allow the building to be further developed into an annex and therefore that the wording should be incidental. The applicant assured the council there was no planned residential use of these buildings. **Public open session closed at: 19:41**

19/01885/FUL – Proposed demolition of disused agricultural buildings and change of use of land and agricultural building to ancillary residential use with alterations - Colestile Farm, Colestile Farm Lane, Pitcombe. BA10 0PJ

Councillor C. Donald asked that the term ancillary was changed to incidental. The council discussed the plan and had no other concerns.

Members discussed the substitution of the word incidental for the term ancillary use.

<u>RESOLVED:</u> It was proposed and agreed that the Parish Council recommends approval of the application, but questioned whether the term ancillary could be changed to incidental.
